

Maintenance Technician

Responsible for installing, maintaining, and repairing machinery and mechanical equipment such as motors, machine tools, process lines, production machines, etc.

Duties and Responsibilities Include the Following:

- Strong repair abilities in the areas of hydraulics, pneumatics, electrical, electronic, and plumbing;
- Demonstrates knowledge and experience in building maintenance/construction as well as heating, air conditioning and ventilation maintenance;
- Reads and interprets equipment and operation instructions and blueprints to perform proper repairs;
- Performs services such as oiling, cleaning and maintaining all equipment as well as following an effective preventative maintenance plan;
- Demonstrates the ability to use all test equipment properly and safely;
- Possesses an advanced ability for troubleshooting and repairing of CNC controls;
- Exhibits good communication skills when working with vendors, suppliers and internal associates;
- Demonstrates knowledge of operating machine tools;
- Visually inspects and tests machinery, vehicles, and physical property;
- Listens for unusual sounds from machines or equipment to detect malfunction and discusses machine operation variations with production team members or other maintenance members to diagnose problem or repair machine;
- Adheres to all safety regulations;
- Possesses a current and valid driver's license for company vehicle use;
- Safely operates Company's Tow Motor;
- Serves as back-up in the absence of the Supervisor;
- Other duties as assigned.

Skills and Experience:

- High School diploma or GED.
- Three (3) to Five (5) years or more maintenance experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Recognized US Dept. of Labor or State of Ohio Journeyman card a plus.
- Ability to work with mathematical concepts.
- Ability to apply concepts such as fractions, percentages, ratios, and proportions to practical situations.
- Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form.
- Ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations.
- Must be resourceful with good personal skills by which to interface with associates and vendors.

Physical Demands/Work Environment:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

While performing the duties of the job, the employee is regularly required to talk or hear. The employee is frequently required to use hands to finger, handle or feel and feet to stand, walk, or climb. Incumbent will be required to maneuver in space restricted areas (repairing machining in confined areas). Job responsibilities demand exposure to the production floor and to chemicals. Company lifting limitations will be enforced. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision and ability to focus. Incumbent may travel locally to direct repairs on company vehicles and/or machining, etc.
